

PACT - What You'll Learn

By the end of the Pre-Apprenticeship Construction Training (PACT) program students should be able to:

- 1.Possess life skills such as practicality, persengrance, positive attitude, and work ethic (A.A. PPPW) that will assure job success as a construction site.
- 2.Possess the qualifications to become indentured in a state-approved construction trade construction. These qualifications are pecific to each approved a state of a command of the proficiency of the profice of t
- 3. Possess the necessary skills to passes the program state Driver's license exam prior to referral to an apprentice of program
- 4. Possess basic construction skills such as knowledge of hand cols & power tools, reading a tape measure, lay-out, blueprints and trades math.
- 5. Possess basic knowledge or the trades in the construction industry.

PACT Certifications

Our Flagging, Forklift Operation OSHA 10, and First Alay Consertification classes are part of the PACT program curriculum and may also be taken as stand-alone classes through the Continuing Education Office.

Flagging Certification: Learn how to establish and maintain a safe traffic flow in a construction zone and understand both haza dous and safe behaviors involved in a variety of flagger situations. Students must take a final test to receive their Washington state flagging certification.

Forklift Operation and Cartification: Study the functions and cartific and cartifity of the first operation and the proper picking and moving of a variety of loads. Both the written and drive tests must be taken and passed in order to receive the Washington State Three-year forklift operator certification.

First Aid/CPR Certification chrough our first and sertification class you'll learn how to respond to specific situations, which will help you fare for people in crisis as they wait for medical professionals to arrive

OSHA 10 Certification: The OSHA 10 course is interced to provide an entry level construction worker's general awareness on construction and preventing the cards on a construction site.


