APPLY



Start the application process the fall of your senior year.

- **Submit** a Seattle Promise application by February 16, 2024.
- **Submit** a college admissions application by February 16, 2024.
- **Submit** a financial FAFSA/WASFA application by April 30, 2024.
- **Complete** a college financial aid file by August 1, 2024.
- **Include** your parents or guardians to help you gather the information you'll need.
- **Attend** a workshop or reach out to the Seattle Promise outreach specialist at your high school for assistance.

Find Your Future

- Free tuition at Seattle Colleges for up to two years, 90 college credits, or a student's first degree, whichever comes first.
- Equity scholarships for books, transportation, housing, etc. for those with financial need.
- Support and advising for students beginning in the junior year of high school through completion of a degree, certificate, credential, or transfer to a four-year institution.
