After completing the Nursing Assistant Certified Short Term Certificate, students are eligible to take the Washington State NAC exam to become a certified nursing assistant. We also offer an Associate in Nursing DTA/MRP for students who want to become registered nurses. This program prepares students for RN licensure and provides a pathway to a bachelor's degree in nursing.

- Send an official transcript to your college of choice to transfer your Seattle Colleges credits.
- If you earned credits from more than one Seattle Colleges campus, request and send a transcript from each campus.
