

Documents for FAFSA

If you **AND** your parent/guardian have any of the following:

- Social Security Number
 - Can be found on Social Security card:



- Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)



- Federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned.

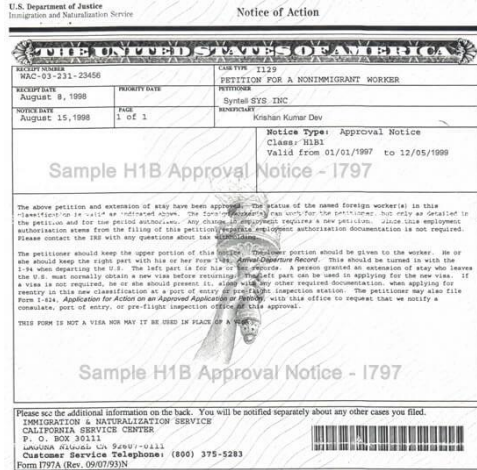


