Graduate Names Collection Process April 2023

- 1. Colleges (N,S,C) send names to District Communications office May 5
 - a. Graduate timeline is Summer Quarter to Summer Quarter

An invitation to participate in commencement is extended to students who:

- Have graduated in Summer Quarter 2022, Fall Quarter 2022, or Winter Quarter 2023, or
- Will graduate at the end of Spring Quarter 2023 or Summer Quarter 2023.
- 2. From *May 5 to May 12*, District Communications:
 - a. Scrubs the list, adds missing emails, and then uploads names to Marching Order. We use Marching Order to communicate to students about commencement logistics, especially:
 - i. The QR code
 - ii. Info about pronunciation function
 - iii. The name displayed on Mariner's Visonboard
 - b. Creates first print layout
- 3. District Communications opens the registration form to students in Marching Order (May 12)
 - a. Register for commencement
 - i. Get QR code
 - ii. Name verification
 - iii. Allows students to provide additional information
 - b. Initiates the auto-communication from Marching Order

4. From *May 5 to May 24*:

- a. Colleges send additions/deletions to District Communications. <u>Students are still able to participate in</u> <u>Commencement if they miss these deadlines.</u>
 - i. Printed program
 - ii. Marching Order
- 5. Graphic designer sends 1st commencement program proof to Colleges for review *May 30*.
- 6. Colleges return graduate names to graphic designer with name corrections / additions for printed program on *May 31*.
- 7. Graphic designer sends 2nd program proof to Colleges for final review *June 2*.
 - a. District Comms creates Grad Facts
- 8. Graphic designer sends final commencement program file to printer *June 6*.
- 9. Printer delivers program to T-Mobile Park on June 22 (Commencement 2023)
