



Promise Perks

In addition to full tuition and dedicated staff to support you every step of the way from 12th grade through completing your associate degree, Seattle Promise students benefit from these Promise Perks.

Peer Mentors

First year Seattle Promise students can join a peer mentor group and get advice from second year Seattle Promise students while connecting with other students. Groups meet monthly throughout the year and your Peer Mentor is available all year for advice and support with navigating college. Joining a group is a great way to get questions answered, make new friends, and get connected to additional opportunities available to students. You'll be able to sign up for a Peer Mentor group this summer and your group will start meeting in fall quarter.

Paid Work Study Opportunities

Work Study jobs are great for students who want/need to work but also need a job that is flexible and understanding with their school schedule. Seattle Promise and Seattle Colleges are regularly hiring Seattle Promise students to support the program, colleges, and other students. Applying to be a Peer Mentor or Promise Ambassador is a great way to earn money while earning your degree. Ask your Retention Specialist about jobs that are currently available.

Paid Summer Internships

Opportunity Promise is a summer internship program open ONLY to Seattle Promise students. Top local organizations offer Seattle Promise students paid summer internships each summer in an effort to help you network, build your resume, and earn valuable work experience while you earn your degree. Opportunity Promise Internship applications open in February each year and internships typically go from early-July to late-August.

Scholarships at local 4-year universities

City University of Seattle (CityU) offers scholarships of \$1,250 per quarter, up to \$10,000 when Seattle Promise graduates transfer to CityU to complete their bachelor's degree.

Seattle Pacific University offers the Transfer Promise, an exclusive, discounted pathway to SPU for Seattle Promise graduates. The discount provides at least 50% off tuition in the form of SPU scholarships and grants in addition to other student supports (like mentoring and special advising).
